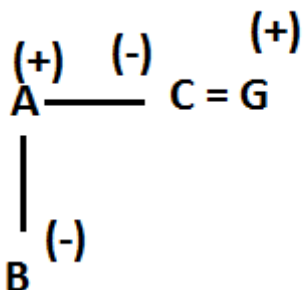

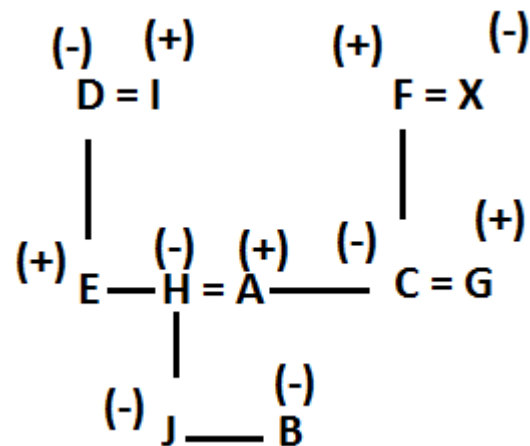

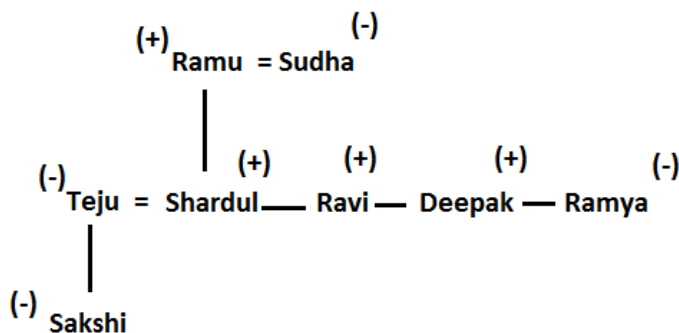
- 1) Ramu has four children. Out of them, only one is married.

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4) Sakshi's mother is the wife of Shardul who has an only sister named Ramya (implies Shardul has two brothers and one sister).

5) Ravi is the younger brother of Shardul.

Solution 7-9

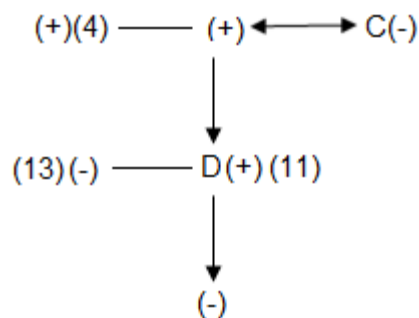
The person with 4 coins is the paternal uncle of D.

Family Tree:



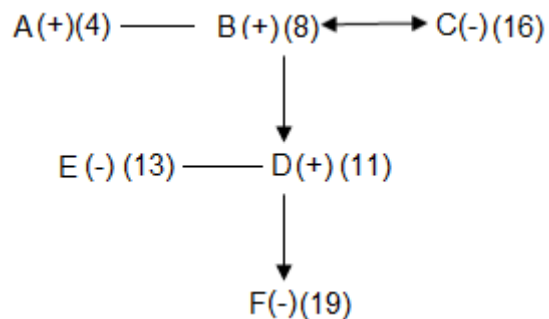
No female has 8 coins, so the husband of C has 8 coins.

Person with 16 coins is elder than F, who has 19 coins, so C has 16 coins and F is the daughter of D.

Neither A nor E is married to C, so B is married to C.

E is younger than A, so E is the sister of D and A is the brother of B.

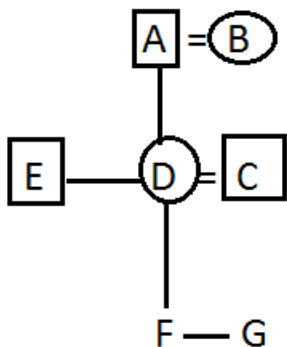
