

- The FIFA World Cup Man of the Match award has been given out following each game since 2002.
- The Golden Ball and Golden Boot are just two of the additional honours granted at the FIFA World Cup.
- The main distinction between these honours and the FIFA World Cup Man of the Match award is that the former is granted after the tournament, while the latter is presented following each World Cup game.

- The National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA India) is hosting an Inclusion Conclave for the first time to put a greater emphasis on anti-doping processes and education for athletes with impairments.
- In addition to WADA Asia-Oceania Regional Office Manager Kenny Lee and UN Resident Coordinator Shombi Sharp, Secretary Department of Sports Smt. Sujata Chaturvedi will also speak at the summit.
- Following the conclave, there will be a two-hour inclusive anti-doping education workshop for athletes with disabilities with a focus on the Therapeutic Use Exemption, the Doping Control Process, Anti-Doping Rule Violations, as well as the rights and obligations of athletes with disabilities and support personnel.
- For athletes with impairments, NADA India has already created extensive UDL (Universal **Design of Learning**) courses on anti-doping education and awareness. UDL is a multi-modal framework that uses sign language visual representation, subtitles that have been translated, and content audio to enhance and optimize teaching and learning for all people.
- Previously solely available in print, certain content is now also available in Braille and audio forms.
- Additionally, NADA India has improved the DCO kit for athletes with impairments and conducted sensitization training for **Dope Control Officers (DCO)** who collect samples from them.

- The competition will feature about 150 players from all over the world, and there will be a total of 24 matches spread among nine Indian cities.
- The tournament is being held to coincide with World Disability Day events around the **World** Cup's opening ceremony on December 5 at Gurugram's Tau Devi Lal Indoor Stadium.
- Yuvraj Singh, a former Indian batter, is the competition's brand ambassador.
- Since 2012, the World Cup has been run by the **Cricket Association for the Blind in India (CABI)** in collaboration with the disability organization Samarthanam Trust.
- The Samarthanam Trust has arranged more than 30,000 visually impaired matches since its establishment.

Saurashtra defeated Maharashtra in the Vijay Hazare Trophy final by five wickets:

- At the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad, Gujarat, Saurashtra defeated Maharashtra by five wickets to win the Vijay Hazare Trophy.
- As captain **Ruturaj Gaikwad reached a century**, hitting 108 off 131 balls after a sluggish start, they contained Maharashtra at 248/9 in 50 overs.
- Bowler Chirag Jani of Saurashtra claimed a hat-trick in the game.
- At the moment, Sheldon Jackson is the man.
- With a 249-run goal to reach, Saurashtra got off to a cautious start until the openers struck a 125-run partnership. As wickets shattered all around him, batter Shledon Jackson clutched one end.
- In 46.3 overs and with five wickets still over, he helped Saurashtra chase down the goal with a match-winning 133 off 136 balls.
- It was the second title victory for Saurashtra in history.

Rudrankksh Patil, a shooter, wins the ISSF President's Cup in Egypt:

- The International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) President's Cup was won by Indian shooter Rudrankksh Patil in Cairo, Egypt.
- In the **10-meter rifle play-off**, he outscored Italy's Danilo Sollazzo 16-8.
- Participants in this competition, which began on November 28, come from 42 different countries and 43 ISSF Member Federations across all continents.
- Rudrankksh Patil, 18, won gold in the men's 10 m air rifle event at the ISSF Rifle/Pistol World Championships 2022 in Cairo, Egypt, which came to an end in October.
- He is now only the sixth Indian shooting world champion, joining gold medalists Abhinav Bindra, Tejaswini Sawant, Manavjit Singh Sandu, Om Prakash Mitherval, and Ankur Mittal.
- India won five medals in the ISSF President's Cup in 2021: gold, silver, and bronze. Among the medal winners were Olympians Manu Bhaker, Rahi Sarnobat, Saurabh Chaudhary, and Abhishek Verma.

Indian captain Rohit Sharma has become the country's sixth-highest ODI run scorer:

- Indian captain Rohit Sharma has surpassed former batsman Mohammed Azharuddin to become his country's sixth-highest ODI run-scorer.
- This feat was done by the batter during India's maiden One-Day International (ODI) against Bangladesh in Dhaka.
- His ODI record now stands at 234 matches and 9,403 runs in 227 innings at an average of 48.46.
- In his ODI career, he has 29 tons and 45 fifties, with the top individual score of 264, which is also the highest score ever in ODIs.
- Azharuddin, who dropped to seventh place, had scored 9,378 runs in 334 matches in 308 innings for an average of 36.92, including seven tons, 58 fifties, and a top score of 153.
- Other Indian ODI run scorers include Sachin Tendulkar (18,426), Virat Kohli (12,353), Saurav Ganguly (11,221), Rahul Dravid (10,768), and MS Dhoni (10,599).

Cristiano Ronaldo has agreed to terms with Saudi club Al-Nassr on a contract worth 200 million euros:

- Cristiano Ronaldo has joined Saudi Arabian club Al-Nassr on a two-and-a-half-year contract worth 200 million euros each season.
- The story was published by renowned Spanish source Marca before the Portugal captain's FIFA World Cup 2022 Round of 16 matches against Switzerland, which is slated for at Qatar's Lusail Stadium.
- Earlier, Ronaldo's agent, Jorge Mendes, had met with several clubs, including European powerhouses such as Bayern Munich, Chelsea, and Atletico Madrid, but no one expressed serious interest in the 37-year-old forward.
- Al Nassr Football Club is a Riyadh-based Saudi Arabian football club.
- The club, founded in 1955, plays its home games at Mrsool Park.
- Yellow and blue are their primary colors.
- Al Nassr is one of the most successful clubs in Saudi Arabia, with 27 championships at the highest level of all tournaments.
- The team has won nine Premier League titles, six King's Cups, three Crown Prince's Cups, three Federation Cups, and two Saudi Super Cups at the domestic level.
- At the international level, they have won two GCC Champions Leagues and achieved the historic feat of winning both the Asian Cup Winners' Cup and the Asian Super Cup in 1998.

FIFA World Cup 2022 trophy will be unveiled by Deepika Padukone:

- According to speculations, Deepika Padukone will showcase the FIFA World Cup trophy in Qatar later this month.
- The trophy will be unveiled on December 18, the day before the World Cup final.
- Deepika will be the first actress to be honored in this manner in the world's most-watched sporting event.
- Deepika Padukone is set to unveil the World Cup trophy at the Lusail Iconic Stadium on December 18.
- Deepika Padukone is an Indian cinema actress who primarily appears in Hindi films.

Sukant Kadam, world No. 3, wins gold at the Peru Para Badminton International:

- Sukant Kadam, world No. 3, smashed his way to gold at the recently ended Peru Para-Badminton International, defeating Singapore's Chee Hiong Ang.
- India received 14 medals in total (6 gold, 1 silver, and 7 bronze).
- Sukant dominated the finals from the start.
- He **defeated Chee Hiong Ang** in straight sets, 21-14 and 21-15.
- The game lasted 32 minutes.
- The ace shuttler didn't miss a beat in the final.
- Nithya Sre Sumathy Sivan and Mandeep Kaur won the SH6 and SL3 singles titles in the women's division.
- Mandeep defeated Ukraine's Oksana Kozyna 21-11, 21-11, while Nithya defeated Peru's Giuliana Poveda Flores 21-6, 21-13.
- Indian men's doubles pair Nehal and Breno Johann (SL3-SL4) and women's doubles pair Parul Parmar and Vaishali Nilesh Patel (SL3-SU5) both won gold medals.
- The Indian pairing of Nehal and Breno defeated Peru's Renzo Diquez Bances Morales and Pedro Pablo De Vinatea 21-16 21-13, while Parul and Vaishali defeated Peru's Kelly Edith Ari Escalante and Mandeep 21-17 21-19.

Saikhom Mirabai Chanu wins silver in the World Weightlifting Championships in Colombia.

- Mirabai Chanu, an Olympic silver medalist, earned silver in the 2022 World Weightlifting Championships in Colombia.
- She defeated China's Olympic champion, Hou Zhihua. Jiang Huihua of China won gold with a combined weight of 206 kg.
- Mirabai hoisted a total of 200 kg, whereas Zhihua only lifted 198 kg.
- Mirabai's second World Championships medal, having previously won gold in 2017 with a lift of 194 kg.
- Mirabai Chanu, participating in her first international meet since winning the Commonwealth Games 2022 in August, struggled with her left wrist in clean and jerk.
- The Indian weightlifter failed her first effort, lifted 111kg on her second attempt, and matched eventual gold medalist Jiang Huihua's 113kg on her third attempt to place third.
- Mirabai of Manipur had previously won gold at the World Weightlifting Championships in 2017.
- She won a gold medal at the 2022 Commonwealth Games.

Stephanie Frappart will be the first woman referee at the FIFA World Cup in 2022:

- Stephanie Frappart of France will be the first woman to referee a men's World Cup match, according to FIFA.
- She will officiate the Group E match between Germany and Costa Rica on December 2, 2022.
- Frappart is one of three female referees chosen from a field of 36 for the tournament in Qatar, joining Rwandan official Salima Mukansanga and Japanese official Yoshimi Yamashita.
- Three other female officials have been assigned as assistant referees during the World Cup.
- Refereeing her men's World Cup match is the next stage in the 38-year-old Frappart's fast journey to the top level in Europe.
- In 2019, she became the first female referee in France's Ligue 1, the same year she presided over the women's World Cup final in her native nation.
- Frappart also refereed the 2019 Uefa Super Cup final between Liverpool and Chelsea before moving on to the 2020 Champions League and the French Cup final last season.

- Mr. Anurag Thakur, the minister of youth affairs and sports, stated that 1,000 Khelo India centers will be operational nationwide by August 15th, 2023.
- He continued by saying that 733 of these 1,000 centers have already received approval.
- Mr. Thakur claimed that India has performed better than in the past at both the Olympics and the Paralympics in Tokyo.
- He claimed that **India had also done well at the Deaf Olympics**.
- The Minister mentioned Khelo India and the efforts made by the government to alter public perceptions of sports.
- He claimed that the Khelo India games have provided amateur athletes a stage on which to perform in front of the entire country.
- According to the minister, the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports' budget has climbed from Rs 1,219 crore in 2014 to Rs 3,062 crore for the upcoming fiscal year 2022–23, or nearly three times as much.
- Thakur highlighted some of India's greatest sporting victories that have occurred since the 2014 election of the Modi administration.

McLaughlin-Levrone and Mondo Duplantis were named the 2022 World Athletes of the Year:

- The World Athlete of the Year honors went to Swedish pole vaulter Mondo Duplantis and American world champion hurdler Sydney McLaughlin-Levrone.
- **McLaughlin-Levrone** twice broke the women's 400-meter hurdles world mark, and Duplantis accomplished three new world records this year.
- Duplantis, a Swede of American descent, won the prize for the second time in three years in 2022 after setting three world records, winning the men's world indoor title in March and taking home the world outdoor gold in July.
- Adriana Vilago of Serbia and Erriyon Knighton of America were chosen winners of the World Athletics' Rising Star of the Year award.
- Vilago placed in the top three of 15 javelin tournaments in 2022.
- She earned gold at the Mediterranean Games and the World U20 Championships in addition to silver at the Munich multisport European Championships.

Amar Singh Devanda from Air Warrior Corp places sixth in Taiwan's 24-hour ultramarathon

- The Chinese Taipai Association's 24-hour ultramarathon saw Air Warrior Cpl Amar Singh Devandar finish in sixth place after running 204.47 kilometers.
- In 510 laps (400 meters each), he completed the stadium in 24 hours.
- At **Soochow University in Taiwan**, the Chinese Taipai Association of Ultrarunners organized the 24-Hour Ultramarathon for the year 2022.
- India was represented at the competition by Cpl Amar Singh Devanda. 31 runners in total, 21 men and 10 women, from 5 different countries, took part in the race.
- During the Asia-Oceania 24 Hrs Championship 2022 in Bengaluru, Cpl Amar set a new national record by traveling 257.618 kilometers on July 3, 2022.
- He was the captain of the **Indian squad that won the championship**.

Sidra Ameen and Jos Buttler have been announced as the ICC Player of the Month honorees for November 2022:

- Jos Buttler, the captain of England that won the T20 World Cup, received the ICC men's **Player of the Month award** for the first time for his outstanding performance in November.
- Sidra Ameen of Pakistan won the women's Player of the Month title for the nation for the second time in a row as a result of her outstanding performance in the ODI series victory against Ireland.
- The ICC Player of the Month award went to Buttler, one of the most potent batters in whiteball cricket, who defeated Adil Rashid and Shaheen Shah Afridi for his outstanding performance in the crucial semifinal match against India and helped England win the T20 World Cup for the first time since 2010.
- The opening batsman for England scored 73 runs off of 47 balls against New Zealand and then 80 runs off of 49, stitched an unbroken 170-run partnership with Alex Hales during England's victory over India in the semifinal, and then scored a crucial 26 against Pakistan in the World T20 final to lead his team to victory.
- Sidra Ameen won the ICC Women's Player of the Month award for her impressive performance against Ireland in the ODI series, amassing 277 runs in three home matches while defeating Gaby Lewis of Ireland and Natthakan Chantam of Thailand.
- She was the second cricketer from Pakistan to receive this award after Mohammad Rizwan (September).

The Hyderabad Strikers have won the Tennis Premier League 2022:

- Hyderabad Strikers have won the 4th Tennis Premier League (TPL) 2022.
- The fourth **TPL final was placed in Pune, Maharashtra.**
- Hyderabad Strikers defeated Mumbai Leon Army (41-32) to win the event for the second year in a row.
- The title was won by Hyderabad's S. Balaji and Nikki Poonacha, who defeated Mumbai's R. Ramanathan and J. Nedunnchezhiyan 14-6. Mumbai Leon Army won the TPL Plus, the Tennis Premier League's grassroots league that provides a platform for young tennis athletes to learn from foreign and Indian stars.
- The winning team received ten lakh rupees, while the runner-up received five lakh rupees.
- Conny Perrin was named "player of the match" in the final, while Sriram Balaji and Jeevan Nedunchezhiyan received the honour in the semifinals.

England's Joe Root joins the ranks of those who have 10000+ test runs and 50+ wickets:

- Former England captain Joe Root became the third cricketer in history to achieve 10,000 runs and take 50 Test wickets.
- He accomplished this during the current second Test against Pakistan in Multan.
- Root accomplished the milestone in the 70th over of Pakistan's second innings at the **Multan** Cricket Stadium, when he bowled Faheem Ashraf.

- Faheem attempted to push at the off-thrown-up spinner's ball.
- The ball spun very little to take the batter's edge and presented Zak Crawley with a routine catch at slips.
- In the longest format, Root joins South African star Jacques Kallis and former Australian captain Steve Waugh in reaching 10,000 runs and taking 50 wickets.
- Root has 10629 Test runs and 50 Test wickets to his name.
- Waugh has scored 10927 runs and taken 92 wickets, whereas Kallis has scored 13289 runs and taken 292 wickets.

Chahat Arora Breaks National Record in 100m Breaststroke at FINA World Swimming **Championships 2022:**

- In Swimming, Indian swimmer Chahat Arora achieved a national record in the women's 100meter breaststroke at the FINA World Swimming Championships 2022 in Melbourne, Australia.
- The 16th edition of the FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) 2022 will finish on December 18.
- FINA stands for the International Swimming Federation.
- Chahat Arora finished the 100-meter breaststroke competition in 1 minute, 13.13 seconds.
- Ruta Meilutyte of Lithuania won the overall heats in 1 minute, 3.81 seconds, 9.32 seconds faster than Chahat Arora.
- Lara Van Niekerk, 19, of South Africa, finished second in 1 minute 3.93 seconds.
- **Lilly King of the United States finished third** in 1 minute and 3.94 seconds.
- Chahat will compete in the women's 50m breaststroke.
- Siva Sridhar will take part in the 100m individual medley.

- It had two victories under Diego Maradona in 1978 and 1986.
- Lionel Messi nearly won in 2014, but La Albiceleste fell to Germany in the championship game 0-1 instead.


